#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Well, what a great 2 weeks of term we have had here at Kurunjang Primary School. This week, we welcomed our 2023 Foundation students and their families to our school and it has been great to see how well our youngest students have all settled into new classes and new school routines. I have been incredibly lucky throughout the week to spend some time in all our Foundation classes and get to know our students, and I am so very proud of how well they have all adjusted to school life here at KPS!

As always is the case in schools, we have a number of key dates and events happening throughout term 1. To help with your planning for the term ahead, here are some important dates for you to put in your diaries or on your calendars:

As mentioned above, we are holding our family fun afternoon next Wednesday the 15th of February from 1.40 pm - 3.10 pm. Each year, we invite families to come along for a picnic lunch and an afternoon of fun activities with our staff and students. We encourage all families to come along as it really is a lovely way to start the year and also get to say hello to your child's new teacher and classmates.

A reminder to all families that our term 1 parent/teacher/student conferences will be held on Wednesday the 22nd of February. This will be a student free day and students will be marked as in attendance if they come in for their allocated Parent/Teacher interview time. Please mark this date on your calendars as students do not attend school as usual on this day. More information including how to book will be provided later this week.

### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

As you would all be well aware, each year our school elects a range of student leaders who help lead our school for the year ahead. This year, I am proud to introduce our Grade 6 school leaders who are as follows:

- School Captains: Harry McIntyre and Prabal Kaur
- School Vice Captains: Denvah Cheung Pun and Lilian Curtis

We congratulate these students on their roles for 2023 and look forward to seeing the many great things they will achieve as leaders over the coming year!

At Kurunjang Primary School, we have developed and implemented the Child Safe Standards in order to help keep our students safe from harm. The Child Safe Standards are compulsory minimum standards for all Victorian schools to ensure they are well prepared to keep children and young people safe and protect them from abuse. The Child Safe Standards include requirements to for schools including:

- involvement of families and students in child safety
- schools' focus on safety for Aboriginal students
- better management of child abuse risks in online environments
- governance, systems and processes for keeping students safe.

There are 11 Child Safe standards that schools must meet and each week for the remainder the term, we will share one with you and what our school currently does to meet that standard in 2023. In the meantime, our policies and Child Safe documentation is all available to view on our school webpage which can be found at <a href="https://www.kurunjangps.vic.edu.au">https://www.kurunjangps.vic.edu.au</a>.

Over the past 2 weeks, we have noticed an increase in students who are coming to school 'out of uniform.' This mainly affects our Grade 3-6 students and is usually regarding jumpers. I completely understand that we have had some unusually cool weather for this time of year, and that not everyone has had the chance or opportunity to organise a school jumper for the year ahead, however we do ask that students do come to school in uniform daily. If students do need to wear a jumper that is not part of our school uniform, where possible we ask that this be of a darker colour. We will allow students to wear jumpers that are not school uniform when outside for the month of February, however we will ask students to remove those jumpers when indoors during learning time. We appreciate your support and understanding regarding our uniform policy.

Kurunjang Primary School is committed to being a child safe organisation and embedding a child safe culture into our practices and processes to ensure all children who attend the school are safe at all times.

#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

As we settle back into school routines and refresh our expectations again in 2023, I believe that it is really fitting to have a focus and spotlight on student behaviour over the coming weeks. Our schools has high expectations of student behaviour, and for our school to continue to be an enjoyable place for all students to learn, these expectations need to be followed by all students at all times. When students do not follow the rules, we will be contacting parents to advise them of this and to ask for your support in turning this behaviour around. It is my firm belief that we can have the biggest impact on student behaviour when schools and parents work together and communicate regularly regarding our wonderful students. In addition, students who do not follow the rules, or who display disrespectful behaviour, will also be given consequences. It is hoped by raising our expectations, and following through consistently when rules are not followed, that we develop a positive school environment for all where everyone knows and understands what is expected of them. I ask for your support and understanding as we refresh and continually improve the behaviour management practices at our school.

Late last week I contacted all families via Compass as it has been brought to our attention that there has been a couple of near misses at our Nimmo Crescent gate. As a result, we would like to remind parents to make sure they are parking legally when picking their students up and to ensure that you are driving with the utmost care and caution as you collect your children each day. It is all of our responsibility to make sure our students get to their parents at the end of each day safely and soundly.

We have also had a number of concerns raised around parents smoking near our entry gates. Here at Kurunjang Primary School, we take the health and safety of our students very seriously and we do ask all parents and carers to refrain from smoking near our school. Department of Education policy states that a person must not smoke cigarettes or e-cigarettes (regardless of whether or not they contain nicotine) within school premises or within 4 metres of the school's boundary fences. We ask all parents and carers to please ensure they are following this expectation as not doing so is a fineable offence. We thank everyone for their ongoing support and understanding as we make our school a safe environment for all.

As has been the case for the last 2 years student assemblies are conducted at 2.30pm on Friday afternoons, alternating each week between years F-2 and 3-6, due to the number of students and size of Kurunjang's gym. We are so excited to announce that in 2023, parents who are available or who would like to attend assembly are now welcome to attend each week and join our children and staff in the gym for their respective assemblies. Parents are invited to attend our assemblies from Friday 17th of February.

Finally, please remember, I always welcome and would love to hear any feedback you have about our school, so please feel to email ANY TIME me at maree.moyle@education.vic.gov.au with any thoughts, concerns, feedback or suggestions that you may have to continue to make our school a wonderful place to be and to learn. I will get back to you as soon as I can and really do appreciate any feedback that you have to share.

# APPLICATIONS FOR CSEF CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSION FUND FOR NEW STUDENTS/FAMILIES

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you have a valid means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. There is also a special consideration category for asylum seeker and refugee families.


Payment amounts this year are \$125 for eligible primary school students. Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

If you applied for CSEF through our school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year, unless you have additional children attending school this year or there has been a change in your family circumstances.

If you would like to apply for the first time at Kurunjang Primary School, please come into the school office to collect an application form.






