PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

The Parent / Caregiver / Guardian Opinion Survey opened yesterday and the link is on Compass. The survey is optional but we encourage all families to participate. Our school will use the survey results to help inform and direct future school planning and improvement strategies.

The survey will be conducted online, only takes 20 minutes to complete, and can be accessed at any convenient time within the survey period on desktop computers, laptops, tablets or smartphones. The online survey will be available in English and 10 other languages including Arabic, Greek, Hakha Chin, Hindi, Japanese, Punjabi, Simplified Chinese, Somali, Turkish, and Vietnamese.

NATIONAL DAY OF ACTION

Tomorrow we are participating in the National Day of Action against Bullying and Violence (NDA). Students are welcome to wear a splash of orange or a piece of clothing that is orange.

The NDA is Australia's key bullying prevention initiative for schools and provides an opportunity to connect with students, staff and our school community to implement workable solutions to prevent bullying.

The 2023 NDA theme, Growing Connections, promotes the importance of school, family and community connections in building safe and supportive learning environments where all students can belong, feel accepted and respected.

Research has shown that strong school connections and positive relationships can help to prevent bullying. When students feel a sense of belonging and connectedness at school, they are more likely to enjoy school, to trust and respect their teachers, and be concerned about and help others (Australian Education Research Organisation 2023).

At Kurunjang Primary School we will help grow connections by promoting inclusiveness, respect and community belonging for all students.

If you have concerns that your child is being bullied, please contact the classroom teacher in the first instance. You will be referred to the Principal if a satisfactory outcome is not achieved. If you believe the behaviour constitutes a crime, or is a serious incident of cyberbullying, please refer to the Bullying. No Way! website for information on how to report to other authorities and accessing wellbeing help.

STUDENT PERSONAL PROPERTY

The Department (which includes our school) does not have accident insurance. Items of personal property that are lost, stolen or damaged at school is not the responsibility of Kurunjang Primary School or the Department. Staff and students are reminded not to bring items of value to school.

ROAD SAFETY

Please speak to your child about crossing the road safely, using the supervised school crossing.

It is also important that as adult role models we encourage our children to enter and exit the car safely when dropping them off. Stopping in the middle of the road to let your child out is not safe for your child, or for other cars using the road. If the council patrolling the school at pick up and drop off times witness this, they can issue a fine.






