#### **STUDENTS WALKING TO / FROM SCHOOL**

We have seen an increase in students walking to / from school by themselves / with siblings or friends. While we encourage our students to enjoy the benefits of walking to / from school, we also want to emphasize the importance of responsible behaviour during these journeys.

Can you please discuss with your child/ren that it is essential that they do not touch or damage any properties along their way home. Remind them that respecting other's belongings is a vital aspect of being a responsible member of our community.

Kurunjang Primary School is committed to being a child safe organisation and embedding a child safe culture into our practices and processes to ensure all children who attend the school are safe at all times.



## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

The safety of our students is always our number one priority and, below are some safety messages to share with your children:

- Always walk or ride directly to and from school and avoiding making stops or side trips along the way.
- Avoid walking or riding alone, whether it's with parents or friends always try to walk in a group.
- If there is anything that makes a student feel uncomfortable in any way, they should leave the area and report any concerns to a responsible adult.
- Avoid talking to strangers – students should walk away from anyone they do not know and tell a responsible adult what happened.
- Avoid getting into cars, even if a student thinks they know someone in the car, unless the student has been told that someone known to them will pick them up.
- Remembering the number plate of a vehicle is of huge assistance to police, however should only be attempted if the student is safe.

These conversations can help ensure that students feel safe and are confident to handle a difficult situation if it arises. I also encourage you to speak to your children and encourage them to report any concerns going to and from school or anything suspicious to you and the school. If you see something that looks suspicious or out of the ordinary please contact the Police.






