PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear parents and carers,

Firstly, I would like to thank the parents and community members for their congratulations and best wishes on my appointment as Principal. I am really looking forward to working with you all and going on our journey together as we implement the 2024-2027 School Strategic Plan.

Our Foundation students and staff headed off to Animal Land this morning. The students were extremely excited about their first school excursion and seeing the different farm animals. I think we will have some tired staff and students this afternoon.

FOUNDATION 2024

On Wednesday, our 2024 Foundation students had their first transition experience. It was great for our newest Kurunjang PS learners to build connections with each other, which will ultimately form their learning community for next year. Staff have commented on how settled the students were, which is fantastic. I am pleased to announce that our 2024 Foundation teachers will be Amy Leahy (Team Leader), Isabella Kamenjarin, Lyndal Ryan and Kaitlin McCall.

FOUNDATION ORIENTATION SESSIONS

If you know someone who will be starting Foundation next year, please encourage them to enrol as soon as possible as our transition sessions will be taking place soon. All sessions will run for 90 minutes from 9:30am to 11:00am. These sessions provide an opportunity for the teachers to get to know the students and for the students to begin to connect with school and their peers.

PERSONAL PROPERTY

KURUNJANG ARTS FESTIVAL

This year KPS will be having a whole school end of year concert to be held at the school in the Gym. All students will attend school for the day as normal and will perform at their allocated time once the concert has begun.

Your child will be performing and returning to class after their performance. Therefore, all children are required to remain at school for the whole school day. We ask that during the performance all audience members remain seated until the end of the concert.

So that families can have an opportunity to be in the audience, we are asking that families of certain house colours attend on certain days.

The concert will commence at 1pm sharp with students dismissed from their classrooms at 3:10pm.

Each day, after the concert the KPS Art Show will run in the Personal Learning Studio with artwork on display from the students. We ask that families from the house colour group on that day come visit the Art show to view their child's art pieces from 3:10pm to 4:30pm

Assisted Transition Day & Support Meetings: Tuesday 5th of December

Assisted Transition Day is an orientation day for students requiring additional support in their transition to Secondary School. If you believe that your student would benefit from this extra support, please speak to your Primary School.

State Wide Transition Day: Tuesday 12th of December

All 2023 Grade 6 students in Victoria attend their destination secondary school on this day. Students should meet at the REC (gymnasium) at 8:45am on this day. Students will be dismissed at 3:10pm. Students should bring their lunch, drink bottle and something to write with. They may order lunch from the canteen on this day. Students should wear their Primary School Uniform.

Ready to Learn Morning: Tuesday 30th of January 9am to 12pm noon

This is the morning that year 7 students will receive their locker, timetable, planners and meet their STARR connect teacher. It is an opportunity for students to practice navigating around the school before their classes start officially. Students will arrive at school and will speak to a staff member that will support them to find their locker. Year 7 students can attend alone, with an older sibling or support person, or with a parent or carer. Students should wear their MSC uniform.

First Day of School: Wednesday 31st of January

Head straight to your STARR Connect classroom at 9am, your teacher will then walk your class over to the REC (gymnasium) at 9:05 am ready for a 9:15am for an assembly. Students will sit in their class group. Classes will be displayed at the entrance to the REC.


