

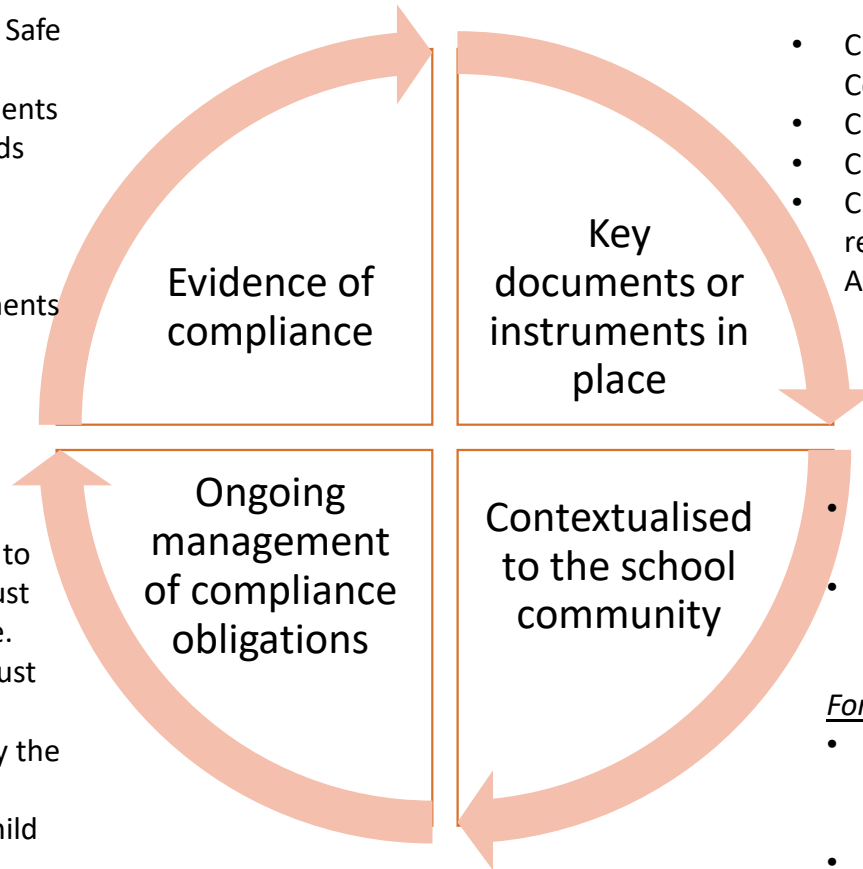
# Child Safe Standards Compliance

## Demonstrate

- School Council minutes approving Child Safe Standards Strategies
- School Council forward planning documents including training on Child Safe Standards
- Newsletter and communication to the school community
- Induction guides and visitors signage including Child Safe Standards requirements

## Maintenance

- Child Safety Policy or Statement of Commitment to Child Safety, Code of Conduct and procedures for responding to and reporting suspected Child Abuse must be publically available on school website.
- Child Safe Standards Risk Assessment must be reviewed regularly
- Training must be undertaken annually by the school council and staff.
- All recruitment must comply with the Child Safe Standards requirements
- Celebration of cultural days and acknowledgment of CALD communities through events

- Child Safety Policy or Statement of Commitment to Child Safety
- Child Safe Standards Code of Conduct
- Child Safe Standards Risk Assessment
- Child Safe Standards procedures for responding to and reporting suspected Child Abuse
